

|  | FGCU Early Admission Information for Students |  |
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Students interested in early admission opportunities at Florida Gulf Coast University are required to schedule an appointment with their school counselor to determine whether initial eligibility criteria has been met. Once that determination has been made, students will be provided information regarding the necessary application, testing, and registration processes to follow.

## Criteria for FGCU's Accelerated Collegiate Experience (ACE) Program:

$\checkmark$ At time of application, be a rising junior or senior in high school.

- Completion of a minimum of 4 semesters of high school (student should not have completed sufficient units to qualify for high school graduation, and must apply all credits earned to meeting high school graduation requirements and University criteria for degree completion).
$\checkmark$ Demonstrated exceptional ability as substantiated by a recommendation from the high school.
$\checkmark$ Completed ACE online application and associated forms.
$\checkmark$ Approval of parent or guardian.
$\checkmark$ A minimum 3.7 weighted high school grade point average AND a minimum 3.0 unweighted high school grade point average.
$\checkmark$ Composite test scores on the ACT of 23 or higher AND minimum score of 20 for English, math, and reading subtests.


## OR

$\checkmark$ Composite test scores on the SAT of 1600 or higher AND minimum score of 500 for critical reading, writing and math subtests (taken prior to March 2016) OR composite test scores on the SAT of 1070 or higher AND minimum score of 500 for evidence-based reading and writing and math subtests (taken March 2016 and after).
$\checkmark$ Approval of the Director of the Accelerated Collegiate Experience.

Students must be eligible under an Accelerated Credit Contractual Agreement between FGCU and the student's current institution.
